

Introducing our new Sunday School Co-Directors Kevin and Tara Spurlin



"I have never understood the differing accounts of the 30 pieces of silver and subsequent death of Judas found in Matthew 27:3-10 & Acts 1:18-19"

Acts 1 offers a kind of flashback, providing new information to fill a gap left by Matthew and Luke's Gospels concerning Judas. We learn that actually Judas bought a field with his "wicked wages" and killed himself, presumably by jumping headfirst off a precipice of some sort, bursting his body open upon impact. Matthew and Luke were probably writing independently of one another around the same time period. They both include the field of blood and the association of its purchase with the money paid to Judas to betray Jesus. Both accounts believe Judas committed suicide and they differ on the mode. One could argue that he hung himself and then when his body fell to the ground it could have burst open.

Whether Judas paid for the field directly or the religious leaders used the money he returned to purchase the field, the bottom line is that the field was paid for by the money given to Judas to betray Jesus.
