I know the Lord can use us to bless those brothers and sisters on that very poor island, so I told our congregation about this family and their response was amazing. We decided to collect money and buy them blankets and sweaters for the winter. Even some of our children wanted to participate! We collected \$700 and sent it to Mexico (this is \$13,000 in pesos). We are blessed that we can give thanks to the Lord for all we have by sharing His love and mercy with people in need. "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was in prison and you came to visit me." She didn't just serve the people of China, she identified with their with customs and culture and was eventually accepted by many, even having some accept Christ as their Savior.

Our church's goal this year for the Lottie Moon Christmas **Offering is \$3,000**, with 100% of this going directly to sustain the international missionaries and their work. Lottie Moon offering envelopes will be available in the pews for your convenience.


