The Month of "Love"

The history of Valentine's Day—and the story of its patron saint—is shrouded in mystery. We do know that February has long been celebrated as a month of romance, and that St. Valentine's Day, as we know it today, contains vestiges of both Christian and ancient Roman tradition. https://www.history.com/topics/valentines-day/history-of-valentines-day-2

While some believe that Valentine's Day is celebrated in the middle of February to commemorate the anniversary of Valentine's death or burial—which probably occurred around A.D. 270—others claim that the Christian church may have decided to place St. Valentine's feast day in the middle of February in an effort to "Christianize" the pagan celebration of Lupercalia. Celebrated at the ides of February, or February 15, Lupercalia was a fertility festival dedicated to Faunus, the Roman god of agriculture, as well as to the Roman founders Romulus and Remus. https://www.history.com/topics/valentines-day-2

Lupercalia survived the initial rise of <u>Christianity</u> <u>but wa</u>s outlawed—as it was <u>deemed</u> "un-Christian"—at the end of the 5th century, when <u>Pope</u> Gelasius declared <u>February 14 St. Valentine's Day.</u> It was not until much later, however, that the day became <u>definitively</u> associated with love. https://www.history.com/topics/valentines-day/history-of-valentines-day-2

With much reading and research, there is more to the holiday than one would consider. Valentine's day is shrouded in mystery, paganism, and Christianity. So rather than celebrating one day to love another (seemingly forced upon us), I would encourage you to think about every day being a day for each of us filled with the intent to love. We should not relegate just one day to show our love and appreciation for one another (especially our spouses and family members). The scripture is very clear on how often we should love one another.

1 John 4:7-12, 19

7 Dear friends, let us love one another, because love is from God, and everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. 8 The one who does not love does not know God, because God is love. 9 God's love was revealed among us in this way: God sent His One and Only Son into the world so that we might live through Him. 10 Love consists in this: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 11 Dear friends, if God loved us in this way, we also must love one another. 12 No one has ever seen God. If we love one another, God remains in us and His love is perfected in us. 19 We love because He first loved us.

Love as Paul defines in 1 Corinthians 13, is a love that is sacrificial without any expectation of return. This is the love God showed us on the cross of Jesus Christ and therefore is the same love we must show one another. We sing, "They Will Know We Are Christians by our Love, by our Love... yea They Will Know We Are Christians by our Love" and may that be our mantra for FBC Galax!
