The questions we ask and attempt to answer with our lives as leaders and as churches give shape to who we are and who we are becoming. If our most meaningful questions are:

- ♦ "How many people attend our worship service?"
- ♦ "How much money are we bringing in?"
- ♦ "How many programs do we have each week?"

This can orient us to doing a good job of counting but a poor job of measuring transformation. As we move forward and begin to reopen, come to life again, I think we need to start to ask ourselves a different set of questions. Let us think about the outcomes we are looking for and God's call on our church, to be able to then ask the questions to accomplish these outcomes.

JR Woodward has four questions he asks of churches that want to re-imagine their purpose and calling to be more of a missional minded community of faith. JR writes:

- 1. Do I have a life worth imitating?
- 2. Do we have a community worth joining?
- 3. Do we have a mission worth dying for?
- 4. Is what we are multiplying reproducible?

In Gil Rendle's book, Doing the Math of Mission, he makes two really important distinctions between counting ministry and measuring ministry and the importance of doing both. He says, "counting is giving attention to numbers" and "measuring is giving attention to change.

I believe it is vital for us to reflect on and think about the church and its culture we want to live into. Especially, as we move to re-open the church and how we can reach our community, to be able to accomplish the transformation that the Gospel calls us to. May we begin together to re-imagine what our purpose may be during Covid-19 as we re-open.

# A Word **FROM** THE MUSIC MINISTER

"And those the Lord has rescued will return. They will enter Zion with singing; everlasting joy will crown their heads. Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.'

Isaiah 35:10 NIV

The beginning of June is just days away, and still we continue to distance ourselves from social gatherings. I hope that this interesting time in our nation's history finds you and your families staying strong and heathy. I am reminded of the hymn "He Keeps Me Singing" by Luther Bridgers. Robert J. Morgan states in THEN SINGS MY SOUL (his 2011 edition on pg. 529) that "though battered by life, the patriarch Job declared that God is able to give us 'songs in the night' (chapter 35 verse 10); that God is strong enough to keep us singing, even in the night seasons." Mr. Bridgers experienced unimaginable tragedy in his lifetime, and after a lengthy recovery from grief and depression, he wrote this hymn because "he recalled the Bible's promise of 'songs in the night.' " Ponder these verses, and may they minister to all of us during this unprecedented time:

There's within my heart a melody; Jesus whispers sweet and low, "Fear not, I am with thee, peace be still, In all of life's ebb and flow, Jesus, Jesus, Jesus, Sweetest name I know, Fills my ev'ry longing, Keeps me singing as I go.
