One of the worst Sundays for me in almost nine years was last winter when one of our members, who had recently been discharged from the hospital, left our morning service because it was too cold. He is back with us now, but that was embarrassing.

The problem was we had "milked" our 47-year-old HVAC system a year too long in order to save spending the \$212,000 it cost to replace. Consequently, at our July business meeting, the congregation wisely voted to modernize our system.

We will pay for this huge expense from our emergency savings and by expanding our current line of credit. We are not thrilled about taking on more debt (we have been paying off our line of credit ahead of schedule), but truthfully, we can't wait any longer. The time is now.

I need your help. Please join me in donating a one-time capital improvement gift on **September 23, 2018** so we do not have to borrow as much money. No gift is too big or too small. I plan to give the proceeds from at least two of the steers I will soon sell from the farm. Let's not give God a cold shoulder, let's turn up the heat!

GREETINGS FROM OUR HISPANIC Hispanic Congregation!

What a blessing! We have seen the hand of God working among our lives, families and church. On June 30th, we had a yard sale and raised \$792 - money that will be used to repair the kitchen area.

During the month of July, we dedicated Sunday afternoons to talk about family and marriage, and specific topics for young people were addressed by young Daniel Sánchez.

July 26th-29th, the Lord blessed us greatly with the first Spanish Vacation Bible School in the city of Galax which was held in our church. The data are as follows: Thursday: we had 55 students and 19 servers for a total of 74 in attendance. Friday: we had 51 students and 21 servers for a total of 72. Saturday: we had 31 students and 22 servers for a total of 53. Sunday: we had 43 students and 22 servers for a total of 65 in attendance. On Sunday, we had 5 adult visitors. In total, there were 9 professions of faith - of which 3 were adults!

We are currently preaching on "One Heart for God" on Sundays in the morning, and "Walking with God" on Sunday afternoons.




Love Must Begin Somewhere!


