
WILLING PARTNERS NEEDS OUR HELP!

You know, I just love that we are considered family in the eyes of God and can relate to each other in that way. Maybe that's because family ministry is such a passion of mine. I love to see families in worship and fellowship together. I believe that parental and adult participation is an essential part of any youth and children's ministry and that more will always be caught than taught.

If you haven't already, you will notice as the future rolls into existence that I am always reaching out to involve our adults in ministry with the kids of FBC. They won't tell you and may even try to keep you from getting involved, but believe me, they need you! I recall a Barna study I read not too long ago. They polled a large number of students that remained involved with their local church even though so many were falling away. These are adults of all ages, not just the parents of their friends. Your involvement with what they are doing and pouring into their lives makes all the difference! As we keep moving toward in-person worship and fellowship, I ask you to pray about how God might be leading you to invest in the lives of our young people. You don't need to be a bible scholar or have all of the answers. You don't need to be young or old or have any special talents. You just need to be willing to allow God to use you, your faith and your life experiences to help encourage and train up the next generation.

A WORD FROM THE MUSIC MINISTER

"Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever." Psalm 118:1 NKJV

As September arrives, we are back to in-person worship, Wednesday evening prayer time, youth events, and Sunday school classes, all with safety measure in place. Things are slowly returning to "normal," but sadly, choir is not one of these activities. The experts say it's still not safe to sing...so a special hello to my choir folks! I miss our times together leading in worship.

I was reading in Robert J. Morgan's THEN SINGS MY SOUL (2011 edition, pg. 11) and was struck by these words from Harold Brown. "The ability of one man without political office or power to change history solely by his teaching and example is without parallel... until Martin Luther would once again transform Europe from his pulpit Mr. Morgan is telling the story of Bernard of Clairvaux and his calling to ministry. "[He] fought heresy and helped preserve the doctrine of the Trinity. He [also] advocated a militant faith that depended on both sword and Spirit. This man, then, is a paradox to us. We don't know whether to claim him or disdain him."

Let us hear these words from "O Sacred Head, Now Wounded" as we might from a hallway in a monastery and consider what God has done for us.

O sacred Head, now wounded, With grief and shame weighed down, Now scornfully surrounded With thorns, Thine only crown; How pale Thou art with anguish, With sore abuse and scorn! How doth that visage languish Which once was bright as morn!

The Alma Hunt Offering for Virginia Missions will look different in the coming year, reflecting the changing world in which we live as we face the challenges of a global pandemic.

This annual state missions offering is a joint venture of Woman's Missionary Union of Virginia (WMUV) and the Baptist General Association of Virginia (BGAV).

As always, this critical offering seeks to meet real needs of real people by funding ministries in a variety of specific areas. For the rest of 2020 and looking toward 2021, the allocations of this offering are being redirected in a way that will allow us to focus on human needs arising from the COVID-19 crisis.

Changes in Distribution

The state missions offering will be distributed as follows:

- 70% of funds to WMUV-directed projects
- 30% of funds to BGAV-directed projects
- All projects have a direct correlation to COVID-19 relief efforts
- Funds will be distributed monthly and will begin in Summer 2020 in order to respond more quickly to immediate needs
