The CDC's credibility when they're pushing woke, LGBTQ language like "pregnant persons" or "birthing persons" instead of "mothers."



Matthew 19:13-14 reads, "13 Then people brought little children to Jesus for him to place his hands on them and pray for them. But the

disciples rebuked them.

14 Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these.

At first glance this would seem to simply permit the children to approach Jesus and it does, but I would assert that this command from Jesus goes a little deeper. I am sure that the disciples and others who were gathered around Jesus that day felt that theirs was a serious business and as such there was no room for the antics of a bunch of kids. After all they were followers of Jesus bringing the good news to people everywhere. They had much ground to cover and many things to

Jesus immediately becomes indignant as they try to herd the kids off and out of the way. He calls them "not to hinder" or in other translations to suffer the children. This is the permit part; permit the children and do not hinder them. However, right after this Jesus makes a profound statement that in my mind truly amplifies his earlier command to permit the children. He states that "the kingdom of heaven belongs to those like these children." This implies that those around have much to learn from these kids and they should be given equal access and perhaps even afforded preference!

If you have never experienced the joy of a child learning of the love of Jesus or the absolute magical expression of a student when the message finally clicks with them, you are truly missing out. Yes, we are all busy doing important things. Heck, we pay our tithes and support funding of our children and youth ministries, but when was the last time you made a personal effort to ensure our youth and children have not only equal access to Jesus, but made a sacrificial effort to give preference within your schedule to help them follow the savior?
