First Baptist Church Preschool Program

The Weekday Preschool Program is an outreach ministry for children in our community.

All classes use the <u>WEE Learn</u> Curriculum Guide for their age group. The guide provides a developmental program that allows children to grow and work as Jesus did – in "wisdom and stature" and in "favor with God and man." Activities are planned so that the children are provided hands-on, concrete learning experiences whereby they work and learn according to their own unique abilities. They are taught through the five senses to help them develop spiritually, physically, intellectually, emotionally and socially. Teachers share songs, books, Bible verses and stories, and conversation as they provide activities in the areas of art, manipulatives, physical activity, books, puzzles, nature, science, home living and music.

The children look forward to chapel each week, led by Pastor Kevin Rosenfeld.

The preschool offers 2-year old classes, 3-year old classes and 4-year old classes.

There are two, three, and four day options.

Each class has at least one lead teacher and one assistant.

The Tuition Cost is \$207.00 per month for 2 days \$235.00 per month for 3 days \$260.00 per month for 4 days

FRAN CREGGAR FUND

The Fran Creggar Fund is a fund that was established in Memory of Fran Creggar.

Mrs. Creggar was a Galax resident that passed away on May 19, 1990. This fund makes it possible for children to obtain financial assistance to attend the preschool program.

Some children would not be able to attend without your help!

All donations to the Fran Creggar Fund are greatly appreciated.

For some children FBC Preschool is the only place they hear Bible stories and songs and are taught that God loves them and made them special!

Sharing what they have learned, children can often lead family members to know Christ!



FBC PRESCHOOL SENSORY ROOM

What is a sensory room?

Sensory rooms in a school setting are intended to be a therapeutic place students can visit to calm, regroup & refocus themselves. Students can visit for a short time when needed or have scheduled time in the sensory room to explore, imagine, or burn off some curious energy.

A sensory station is simply an area that has been set up with the purpose of engaging kids in play that stimulates the senses.

These activities stimulate

children's sense of sight, touch, hearing, taste, and smell.
There are many benefits of sensory play in early childhood, including: cognitive and brain development, language and problem solving, motor skills, creativity, social and emotional development and sensory development.
We are so excited to announce that thanks to a very generous donation, FBC Preschool will be incorporating a Sensory Room into the 2024-2025 school curriculum!

The teachers were so excited when the supplies starting arriving.

They have worked very hard getting everything unpacked and organized for the set up of the Sensory Room.


