

The AED & First Aid Station is Supplied & Maintained by The Cintas Company. An automated external defibrillator (AED) is a medical device designed to analyze the heart rhythm and deliver an electric shock to victims of ventricular fibrillation. The First Aid Center is stocked with various supplies such as gloves, bandages, ointments, alcohol wipes, eye wash solution, etc.

The LifeVac is a non-powered, non-invasive, single-use only airway clearance device developed for resuscitating a victim with an airway obstruction. The device is simple & easy to use. Simply place the mask on the person's face and push the plunger. The obstruction is pulled out when the valve is quickly pulled back up. The LifeVac comes fully equipped with an adult mask, a pediatric mask, and a practice mask. The duration of the suction is minimal which makes the LifeVac safe and effective. The Life Vac devices were donated by Bill Brannon. For instructions on use of the device, please see Bill or Google Life Vac Choking Devices for an instructional video.




