

Galax Area Warming Shelter

Elisha's House is a warming shelter that provides emergency housing to those without shelter or heat on nights when the temperature is 35 degree or below. Elisha's House is located at 222 Carroll Street in Downtown Galax, VA. This is also known as Center 2:42, which is behind Cornerstone Community Church.

First Baptist Church has volunteered to serve on the 28th & 29th of each month (October—March).

If you would like to volunteer, please contact the church Office at 276-236-5185 or email secretary@fbcgalax.org.

A sign up sheet is located outside the church office.

There are three areas of service:

- # 1: 7:30 pm—10:30 pm to Help Register & Assist Guests**
- # 2: 10:00 pm—7:30 am to Assist Guests & Spend the Night**
- # 3: 7:30 am—9:30 am to Clean Up the Center**

Guests arrive at the shelter before the doors are locked for the night at 8:45 pm, unless escorted by the police.

They are provided dinner, supplies, and an opportunity to take a shower and will be offered snacks before lights out at 10:00 pm. The next morning guests are given a gift certificate for breakfast At Hardees and a packed lunch for the day.

Elisha's House is operated by volunteers from Local churches and community partners.

Forecasted temperatures will be monitored for each week. The schedule will be published in advance on The Facebook Page at facebook.com/ElishasHouseGalax.


