## What is Advent?

Advent is a four-week season dedicated to reflective preparation for the arrival, "advent", of Jesus Christ's Nativity at Christmas time as well and Christ's expected return to the Second Coming.

During this important event on the church calendar, each week of Advent focuses on a different theme—  
Hope, peace, love, & joy.

It begins on the Sunday closest to November 30th and ends on December 24th.

It is a time of anticipation and preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ on Christmas Day.

The word "Advent" is derived from the Latin word *adventus*, which means "coming" or "arrival," which translates to the Greek word *Parousia*.

### The Advent Wreath

Lighting candles on an Advent wreath is practiced at First Baptist Church.

The wreath has 5 candles, each representing one of the weeks of Advent.

A new candle is lit on each Sunday leading up to Christmas.


Three candles are purple, and are lit on the first, second, and fourth Sundays of Advent.

They represent a time of prayer, penance, sacrifice and spiritual reflection.

The pink candle is lit on the third Sunday and represents the joy of anticipation for Christmas.

The white candle, also known as the Christ candle, is in the center and is lit on Christmas Eve.

But most of all, there is the joy of celebrating the Savior, Immanuel, God *with us*.






