

COLUMBARIUM
NEWS**



A Columbarium holds the remains of loved ones that have passed. Their remains are known as "cremains" that are placed into a "niche." Niches are the individual compartments within the Columbarium that holds urns.

The First Baptist Church Columbarium holds 64 niches, 32 on each side.

Each niche will hold up to 2 cremains held in urns.

Each urn is labeled with the name of the interred person.

A granite cover, serving as a monument, is placed over the niche with the name and dates of the interred person(s) engraved into the stone.

**Niche Cost is \$1,650 (designed for up to 2 urns).
Engraving name(s) & date(s) is an added cost.**

Columbarium policy and procedures approved by the First Baptist Church, govern the entire inurnment process.




